VSEP	Virginia Substitute Evaluation Program	For students with disabilities (SWD) at secondary level who are not able to access the SOL assessments even with accommodations
COE	Collection of Evidence	Required data for VGLA & VAAP
CWC	Course Work Compilation	Required data for VSEP including evaluation plan
VSTE	Virginia Society for Technology Education	Professional membership, free

WJ-III (R)	Woodcock-Johnson – 3 <sup>rd</sup> Ed. (Revised)	Test of achievement often used by LEAs
VAAP	Virginia Alternative Assessment Program	Designed to evaluate the performance of students with significant cognitive disabilities, grades 3-11
CTONI	Comprehensive Test of Non-Verbal Intelligence	Intelligence test that measures nonverbal intelligence
SRI	Scholastic Reading Inventory	Computer-based reading assessment that measures reading levels and growth, grades 3-11
ARDT	Algebra Readiness Diagnostic Test	Computer adaptive math test used to identify students at risk of failing the SOL Algebra I test, grades 6-9
